Summary

- 70% of SCSD students met English Language Arts standards as 60% compared to for the state
- 56% of SCSD students met math standards as compared to 49% for the state.
- 88% of SCSD students graduate in four years or less as compared to 79.3% for the state.

Context and Support to Our Work

- New Teacher Induction/Orientation has occurred with 13 first year teachers.
- We will be part of the Beginning Educator Grant through ESD 189 this year.
- We implemented the new Math Expressions Program K-5 program last year.

Context to Support Our Work

- We have piloted and purchased Amplify
 Science K-5 to address the Next Generation
 Science Standards. Professional development
 took place on August 19th and 20th.
- Last year 6-12 math teachers reviewed programs.
- We have selected the Envision Program to pilot until January of the year.

Context And Support To Our Work

 We have provided summer school for credit retrieval in grades 9-12 and literacy support for grade 3

• 72 students completed classes for a total of 51 credits
