




Student Enrollment by Demographic (20-21)

One School Highlight

Title I/LAP Interventions

- 151 students served in grades K-5 since Fall 2021
- Tier II interventions focused on fundamental reading skills, such as phonological awareness, sound manipulation, rhyming, phonics, and applying skills to reading
- Tier II interventions provided as direct instruction by Title/LAP staff for grades K & 1 and a combination of "Room" and "Zoom" for grades 2-5
- Tier III interventions focused on phonemic awareness, phonics, and morphemes, fluency and accuracy in reading
- 49 students have exited Title/LAP as of May 1, 2022
- 9 students qualified for Special Education services
